Qualification

Those who are currently enrolled as full-time degree-seeking students in a university with a student-exchange agreement with Seikei University.

Program Fee

JPY 130,000

This price includes tuition, texts, accommodation and field trips.

Flights, overseas insurance, transportation and meals are NOT included.

Note :

Seikei University accepts **Japanese Yen only**.

Overseas bank transfer fees are NOT included in this price. The applicant or their home university have to cover additional overseas remittance fees and other service charges at the local and main bank in their home country.

About the Program

This two-week intensive program is aimed at students who are currently enrolled at our partner universities and are studying the Japanese language. The program consists of Japanese language classes and cultural experience activities. The classes will be decided according to the Japanese language levels of the participants.

1. Beginner Class

This class is mainly for those who have little or no previous experience of learning Japanese.

2. Elementary Class

This class is mainly for those who have learned Japanese to an advanced beginner or lower intermediate level and can understand simple phrases and texts in familiar everyday situations.

Those students who have skills equivalent to the JLPT (Japanese Language Proficiency Test) N4 – N5 levels are best suited to this class.

Each class is designed to improve the practical Japanese skills of the participants. The course content is related to the cultural experience classes. Japanese students will also join the program as PA (Program Assistants) and support the participants' study and campus life during the program.

Activities

We will also offer various activities, such as field trips, cultural excursions and parties organized by Seikei students. The costs for these activities are included in the program fee.

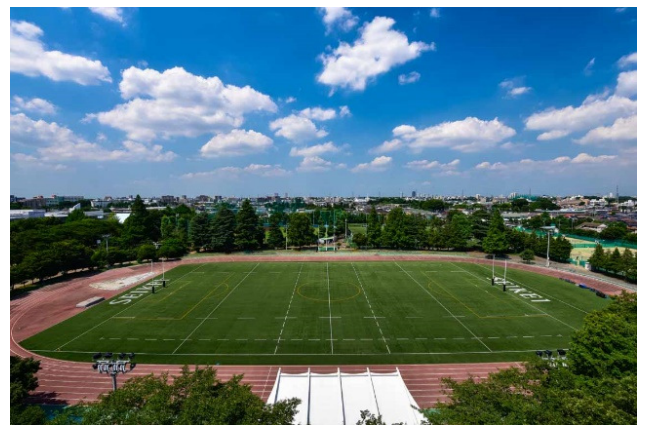

About Seikei University

Seikei University was founded in 1912 and has a long tradition of international students.

About 30 international students are currently enrolled at Seikei, where they study Japanese and faculty-delivered courses.

About Kichijoji

Seikei University is located in Kichijoji in Tokyo.

Inokashira Park

Accommodation

The International House (Kokusai Koryu Kaikan)

Seikei University will accommodate participants at the International House (Kokusai Kouryu Kaikan), the on-campus dormitory.

The student units of the International House are intended for single residency.

Available dates: **Tuesday, May 26th to Wednesday, June 10th**

*The participants are allowed to extend their stay at the International House until **Saturday, June 13th**.

In this case, the cost is JPY2,000 (including utility charges) per night.

Single Unit for Students.

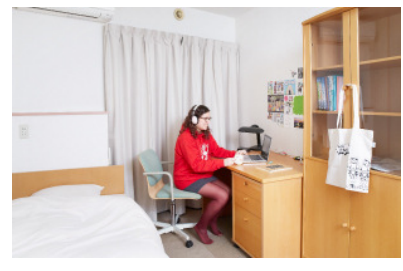

Terrace

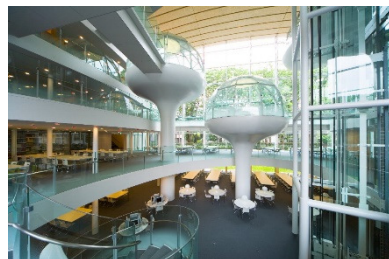
